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## **DEFINITION:**

Is the result of an error while supporting/assisting with medication. For example, incorrect individual, incorrect medication, incorrect time and/or incorrect dosage.

<u>Call 911</u> if immediate medical attention is required (i.e. loss of consciousness, difficulty breathing) and notify Manager or On Call Supervisor as soon as possible.

## PROCEDURE:

## If 911 is not required:

- 1. The Support Worker will:
  - 1.1. Call the individual's pharmacy for direction or if their pharmacy is closed call a 24 hour pharmacy and have all medical information readily available.
  - 1.2. **TELEHEALTH ONTARIO 1-866-797-0000.**
- 2. The Support Worker will document on a MARS/Medication/Treatment Sheet and complete an Incident Report. All Incident Reports must be reported to the Manager / On-Call Supervisor immediately and brought or faxed to the office within 24 hours.
- 3. The Manager / On-Call Supervisor will document the incident and implement corrective action to prevent further errors.
