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Risk Assessment Tool For PPE and source control **Currently staff must always wear a mask while supporting.**

LOW risk individuals:

- Individuals who have not been going out into the community living in a 24/7 setting
- Individuals who do not show any symptoms
- Individuals with no known risky activity or behaviour

HIGHER risk individuals:

- Individuals who have continued to go out into the community unsupervised
- Individuals who have been utilizing city transit
- Individuals who have known to be active in behaviour that may be considered risky (drug use, sharing of cigarettes, smoking discarded cigarettes, social distancing not adhered to)

Low Risk individual PPE when within 2 metres

- Cloth Masks for staff and client (when possible)
- Vinyl or Nitrile Gloves
- Face Shields or goggles

High Risk individual PPE no suspect or confirmed COVID-19 when under 2 meters of personal space and performing direct care with no symptoms

- Cloth Mask for staff and client (when possible)
- Vinyl or Nitrile Gloves
- Face Shield or goggles

High Risk individual PPE when under 2 meters of personal space and performing direct care with one or more symptoms or when directed by public health or management for enhanced PPE

- Medical Mask (Level 1 unless otherwise noted) for both staff and client (when possible)
- Nitrile Gloves
- Face Shield or goggles
- Gown

Confirmed COVID-19 when supporting or self isolation

- Medical Mask (Level 1 unless otherwise noted) for both staff and client (when possible)
- Nitrile Gloves
- Face Shield or goggles
- Gown
- N95 to be worn when entering a room with CPAP or BIPAP in use.
