# GUIDELINES FOR USE OF QUAT PLUS LIQUID DISINFECTANT

#### Use:

Quat Plus is a disinfectant and germicidal detergent. It is suitable for all washable surfaces and is ideal for use in bathrooms, kitchens, floors and wherever disinfection is important. It cleans, disinfects and deodorizes. It is effective in destroying a wide range of bacteria, fungi and viruses, and inhibits growth of mold and mildew. It is safe for food contact surfaces. It does not have a harsh chemical smell

## **Dilution & Mixing:**

This disinfectant is pre-mixed at the main office following safety guidelines, instructions and ratios appropriate for disinfection. The mixture is in a trigger spray bottle that is identified with a workplace label.

## **Safety Data Sheet:**

Although this product is not a WHMIS controlled substance, a Safety Data Sheet is provided for additional information.

## Application:

Soiled or dirty surfaces must be cleaned prior to disinfection – C (cleaning) comes before D (disinfection). Thoroughly apply diluted solution to wet the surface using a mop, sponge, cloth or paper towel, or directly with the trigger spray bottle. Allow surface to remain wet for 10 minutes and then remove excess liquid.

## Frequency of Use:

Apply twice a day, generally once per shift. Frequency may be increased due to staff or client illness or during pandemic/epidemic situations.

## **Precautions:**

Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Wear gloves when using product. Do not spray onto electrical cords. Unplug small appliances before disinfecting surfaces. Do not spray directly onto phones, televisions or small appliances. Some high-touch electronics such as mobile devices, phones, computers and remote controls may require disinfection with rubbing alcohol or alcohol wipes.
